



*From the 'Sunrise' Pattern adapted from Barbara Walker to be worked in the round, this Entomology Beetle Hat cleanly reverses to a lovely cabled hat. My husband commented that he would wear it cabled side out, and I could wear it beetle side out. Either way, it has interesting texture. Perfect for your favorite entomologist! Range Roads are east/west grid roads of Saskatchewan's map.*

## **SIZES**

**Size S:** fits 19-21"—48-53 cm heads

**Size L:** {fits 21-23.5"—53-60 cm heads}

**Finished Sizes: Size S:** 17.5"—44.5 cm

**Size L:** {19.5"—50 cm}

**Depth:** 8-{9"}—20-{23} cm (adjustable)

## **MATERIALS**

**Yarn:** Quince & Co. Lark Color 119/Twig or any worsted weight yarn with good definition and suitable gauge. Pattern is best achieved with solid colors.

**Size S**—2.1 oz or 60 g (160 yd or 150 m)

**Size L**—{2.3 oz or 65 g (175 yd or 160 m)}

**Gauge**—20 sts and 28 rounds/rows works to 4 in (10 cm) in stockinette

**Needles**—US 7 or 8 (4.5 or 5 mm)—16" circular or size for gauge; 4 dpns or two circulars/long circ (Magic Loop) for favorite method of decreasing top (in same size).

Cable needle or spare dpn

Yarn needle, stitch marker
